Dear Sport Field User Groups;

In advance of the 2016 outdoor sport season, I would like to remind all league organizers that the possession and/or consumption of alcohol is not permitted at any of the City's outdoor sport field facilities.

Under The Liquor Licence Act, it is unlawful to possess or consume alcohol on public property, for which no licence or permit is issued to allow such possession or consumption.

The City requires that league organizers remind all coaches, players, and umpires that it is illegal to possess or consume alcohol at any City outdoor sport facility. This prohibition includes the parking lots.

City Staff will continue to monitor its facilities and report violations to the Peterborough Police Service. Individuals who consume alcohol at a City outdoor sport field facility may be subject to criminal charges and/or fines under the Liquor Licence Act.

The City also has the discretion to suspend and/or revoke permits from any league organizer who knowingly permits alcohol consumption to occur at the City outdoor sport facility and/or who fails to assist the City in enforcing its no alcohol policy.
